

Step 1




1a: First you are going to need to get 4 sheets of differently coloured A4 paper to put into a printer. Most home printers will print in reverse so if you want a particular colour to be on your cover, this should be at the bottom of your loading tray.



1b: Then you can print the downloadable PDF onto these sheets. Printing will only be one sided. Try to keep the printed sheets in order.

3: Now you can unfold all of your sheets and lay them flat before assembling them in order, starting from the sheet that will be your cover. Once you have done this, you can close the book.



Step 3


2a: Fold along the dashed lines. This will be the spine of your book.




2c: Once folded, you can cut along the solid lines which will make a series of shaped holes in the paper.



2b: Fold along the dotted lines. These will help you cut the different shapes of the book. You can fold only where dotted, or with young children, it may be easier to fold all along the length of the paper.



4: Be ready for the last step: the binding. This part might be a bit tricky, and you might ask a grown-up for help. Fold the pages like shown on the picture, but not too hard, just enough to allow the stapler to reach the binding line. Staple at nearly 2 cm from the top. Repeat the same at the bottom.
